Read a rhyming book—talk about the words that rhyme. Try to rhyme your name!	Take a walk and talk about the things you see as you go.	Come to the library and participate in a library program!	Read a book by Mo Willems. Which book?	Read a book with your name in it. Which book?
Catch your parents reading for fun! Children mirror what they see their parents doing.	Use a museum pass to go to a museum and talk about what you see there!	Read a book by Jan Brett. Which book?
